It is with great joy that we announce the joining of our two life-affirming pregnancy resource centers, Aid for Women and WomanCare Services. The two pregnancy resource centers are now operating as Aid for Women, Inc.

Some of you may be familiar with one organization or the other, so allow us to give a brief background of each. Aid for Women was founded in 1978 by Deacon Thomas Bresler. Located in downtown Chicago on Michigan Avenue, Aid for Women attracts clients mainly from the south and west sides of Chicago. WomanCare Services, located on Oak Park Avenue in Berwyn, was founded more than five years ago by Laura Nelson, and mainly serves the Hispanic community in the Berwyn/Cicero area. Both organizations share the same belief that life must be protected from the moment of conception. We share the same mission – to reach out to women who might be considering abortion and offer them hope and the material resources necessary to choose life.

Many in the pro-life community have urged us to unite our efforts and work more closely to help end abortion. By consolidating our operations, we are confident that we will better serve those women who come to us seeking alternatives to abortion. Obviously, efficiencies will be gained and redundancies eliminated in the areas of program services, client outreach/advertising, administration, and fundraising activities.
